4th Vienna Ethnography Laboratory, 26. – 28. September 2018

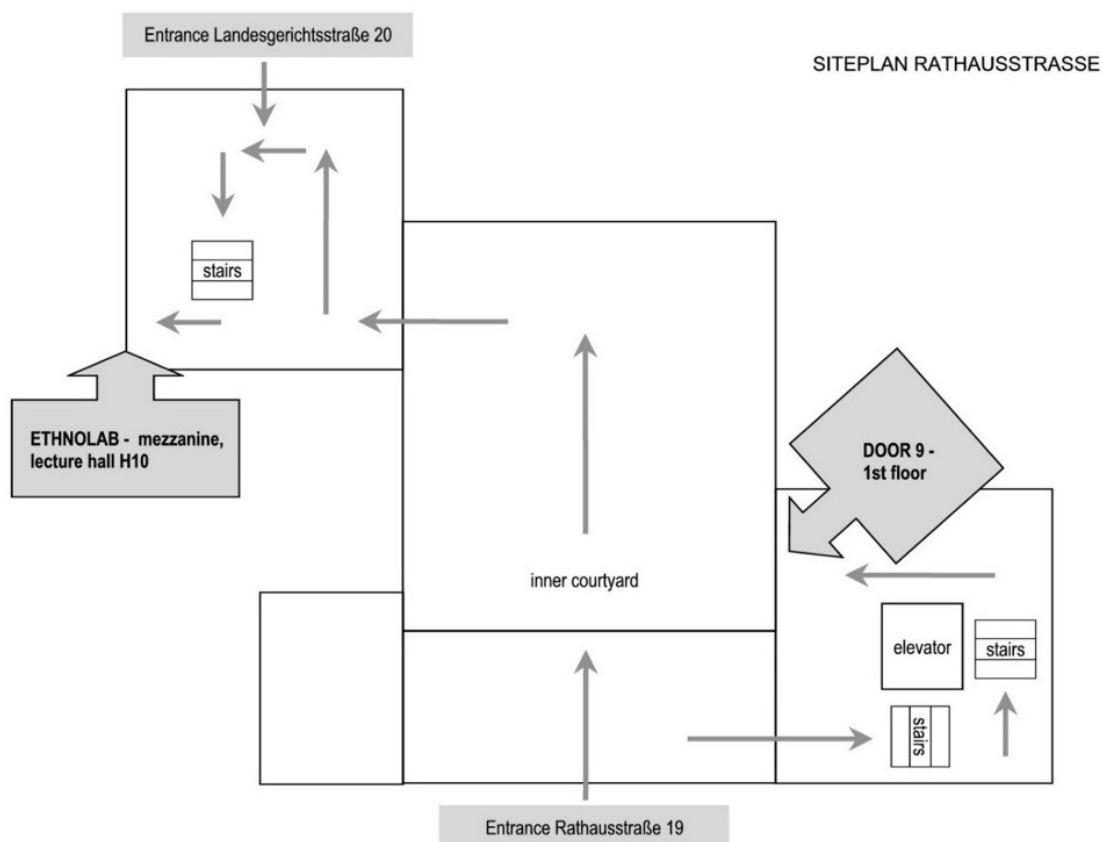
## General Proceedings:
